Hello, thank you for taking the time to read this letter. My name is Dennis Kemper, owner of Kemper Concrete Inc. We decided to draft and send out some information regarding our company to make contractors aware of our services.

What started out as a mainly residential projects, including sidewalks, in ground pool bottoms, garage and basement floors, driveways etc. we started to venture to more of the commercial and agricultural side of concrete including big floors, foundations for steel buildings, and general agricultural concrete work. Throughout the 16 years of business, it became more and more apparent that an efficient method of pouring large concrete floors was necessary if we were to continue on this path. Over the years, we purchased ride on power trowels and other equipment necessary for large slabs, and now that we could finish serious square footage, what we really needed was a way to place concrete efficiently and accurately. We wanted something light weight like the Somero Copperhead, but that utilized down pressure, so that it would not 'float' over high spots. We decided to attend the concrete show in Las Vegas this winter to shop for ideas. We ultimately purchased a 4 wheeled, drive in laser screed built by Somero Enterprises. Weighing in at 1550 lbs, this machine is light enough to screed mezzanines, drive over properly chaired rebar and drive over styrofoam with radiant heat lines. Some applications are not ideal for this machine such as regular wire mesh because it drives over and pushes it down, but can be overcome with chairs or switching to a rebar grid, or switching to synthetic fibre reinforcement. A boom screed would address this type of reinforcement more effectively. We are actively looking for more contractors who are in need of our services. One of our clients recently told me that 'no matter how good the building looks, when the customer opens the door and walks in their new building, they base their judgement on the floor quality'. Kemper Concrete is for hire to laser screed, pour, and finish or just laser screed for your crew.

In addition to nice concrete floors, we spend our time pouring nice concrete walls. Using the duraform type formwork, we are able to construct walls for commercial and agricultural. We tend to stay away from residential. Having constructed steel buildings, we are aware of the tight tolerances contractors are looking for in a concrete contractor. Especially the anchor bolts. A nice level foundation with anchor bolts correctly placed is a dream come true for the erector and site super, eliminating costly downtime and frustration.
